ABOUT THE PROJECT

The Association for Reproductive and Family Health (ARFH) is currently implementing the Integrated Child Health and Social Services Award (ICHSSA), in Lagos State, in partnership with Project HOPE and FHI360, with support from the United States Agency for International Development (USAID) and the Lagos State Ministry of Youth and Social Development (MYSD).

The Project seeks to mitigate the impact of HIV/AIDS on vulnerable children and their households in ten LGAs namely Agege, Ajeromi/Ifelodun, Apapa, Badagry, Kosofe, Lagos Island, Lagos Mainland, Ojo, Shomolu and Surulere. It is a five year project (2019-2024), with a critical mass of ten community based organizations (CBOs). Scope of Services to Vulnerable Children and their Caregivers:

- Health, Education,
- Food/Nutrition, Psychosocial,
- Legal protection,
 Economic strengthening
- Social protection
- Household Economic Strengthening

In line with PEPFAR and UNAIDS "95-95-95" Goals, the ARFH-ICHSSA Project will facilitate identification of HIV positive children, linkage to treatment and supported to achieve viral load suppression.

Provision of block grants, educational materials and school kits for vulnerable children




Mainstream out-of-school children into formal school systems.

AREAS OF SUPPORT NEEDED

- Provide educational support/conditional scholarships to vulnerable children (payment of fees, purchase of school kits – uniforms, books, etc.)
- Support the provision of life skills programs for vulnerable children aged 10years and older.
- Provide education block grants to schools attended by vulnerable children and support with renovation, refurbishment, library facilities and provision of Water Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH), toilet and borehole facilities.
- Support the training of Youth through empowerment/entrepreneurship programs and facilitate their linkage to potential employers.
